MultiStore Polling with pcANYWHERE

Version 9.0 and 9.1

This file contains a listing of files used for Automated Polling using pcANYWHERE32 v9.0 or v9.1 for Win95/98 by Symantec. These files are contained in the file MRGPCAW9.ZIP, located in the **Keystroke** program directory.

Terms:

Master

The location of the computer (or network) where all data files will be. This is where the Consolidated Data directory (DATA) and the sub-directories (STORE1\ & STORE2\) will be located.

Remote

The physical store located at a different location than the Master.

NOTE: pcANYWHERE refers to the Remote location as the HOST, which differs from our use here.

Contents of the File MRGPCAW9.ZIP

CHKSTAM1.BAT – File used to verify valid files at the remote location. Place this file in the \KEYSTROK\ directory at the Store1 remote.

CHKSTAM2.BAT – File used to verify valid files at the remote location. Place this file in the \KEYSTROK\ directory at the Store2 remote.

EXT1.BAT – File used to run EXTRACT.EXE at each remote location. Place this file in the \KEYSTROK\ directory at the Store1 remote.

EXT2.BAT – File used to run EXTRACT.EXE at each remote location. Place this file in the \KEYSTROK\ directory at the Store2 remote.

EXTRACT1.SCR – pcANYWHERE Script file called by MERGEAW.BAT for Store #1. Place this file in the ..\PCANYW~1\DATA\ directory at the Master.

EXTRACT1.SCX – File used by pcANYWHERE. Place this file in the ..\PCANYW~1\DATA\ directory at the Master.

EXTRACT2.SCR – pcANYWHERE Script file called by MERGEAW.BAT and MERGEAW1.BAT for Store #2. Place this file in the ..\PCANYW~1\DATA\ directory at the Master.

EXTRACT2.SCX – File used by pcANYWHERE. Place this file in the ..\PCANYW~1\DATA\ directory at the Master.

MERGEAW.BAT – Master Control File for 2 REMOTE location, runs pcANYWHERE and Keystroke executables (.EXE). Place this file in the \KEYSTROK\ directory at the Master.

MERGEAW1.BAT – Master Control File for 1 REMOTE location, runs pcANYWHERE and Keystroke executables (.EXE). Place this file in the \KEYSTROK\ directory at the Master.

MRGPCAW9.TXT – This document in a text(.txt) file.

MRGPO1.BAT – File used to merge Purchase Orders sent from the Master. Place this file in the \KEYSTROK\ directory at the Store1 remote.

MRGPO2.BAT – File used to merge Purchase Orders sent from the Master. Place this file in the \KEYSTROK\ directory at the Store2 remote.

SEND1.SCR – pcANYWHERE Script file called by MERGEAW.BAT for Store #1. Place this file in the ..\PCANYW~1\DATA\ directory at the Master.

SEND1.SCX – File used by pcANYWHERE. Place this file in the ..\PCANYW~1\DATA\ directory at the Master.

SEND2.SCR – pcANYWHERE Script file called by MERGEAW.BAT and MERGEAW1.BAT for Store #2. Place this file in the ..\PCANYW~1\DATA\ directory at the Master.

SEND2.SCX – File used by pcANYWHERE. Place this file in the ..\PCANYW~1\DATA\ directory at the Master.

Notes:

1. The following directories must be created:
 - \KEYSTROK\STORE1\HOLD at Master.
 - \KEYSTROK\STORE2\HOLD at Master.
 - \KEYSTROK\STORE1 at Store1 Remote.
 - \KEYSTROK\STORE1\HOLD at Store1 Remote.
 - \KEYSTROK\STORE2 at Store2 Remote.
 - \KEYSTROK\STORE2\HOLD at Store2 Remote.
2. The file STORE1\HOLD\EXTRACT.DAT and STORE2\HOLD\EXTRACT.DAT must exist. This file has been supplied, but needs to be edited and the appropriate start date must be used. Other lines represent recommended settings.
3. If Store#1 is at the same location as the Master (you are using MERGEAW1.BAT), live sales for this store will be saved in the \STORE1\ data directory. This requires the use of the /D STORE1 startup switch when starting **Keystroke**.
